Mr. Ed Estepp, Jr., 75, of Cleveland, NC and formerly of Matewan, WV passed away Tuesday, March 15, 2016 at Novant Health Rowan Medical Center.

He was born December 19, 1940 in Matewan, WV, and was the son of the late Ed Estepp, Sr. and Rosie Justice Estepp.

Mr. Estepp was employed for Norfolk-Southern Railroad as a carman in Williamson, WV before retiring.

He was veteran of the US Army from 1958-64 and received the Good Conduct Medal.

Mr. Estepp was preceded in death by his sisters, Bernice Cox and Suretha Steele and his brothers, Thomas Estepp, Bill Estepp and Dallas Estepp.
