Eleanor Mae LeVan Peeler, 88, died November 3, 2020 at Novant Health Rowan Medical Center.

Born in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania on November 30, 1931, she was raised in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and was the daughter of Joseph O. LeVan and Mae Lane LeVan. She was a graduate of Brentwood High School and Catawba College.
