Mrs. Elizabeth "Libby" Helms Hoffmire, 59, of Blowing Rock, NC passed away Sunday, August 27, 2017 unexpectedly when visiting family in Rowan County, NC.

Libby was born September 22, 1957 in Salisbury, NC to Sally Sedberry Helms, of Salisbury, NC and the late JP Helms. She was a graduate of Salisbury High School, attended Appalachian State University and graduated from Kings Business College in Charlotte, NC. Libby worked for GE Corporation in Raleigh, NC ; the Department of Social Services of Boone, NC; served as Clerk for Watauga County Board of Commissioners and as Office Manager for Village Real Estate in Blowing Rock, NC.

She was a member of Rumble Presbyterian Church in Blowing Rock, NC. She played the flute and piccolo for the Salisbury Symphony. Libby played the piano and reached concert-level performance on the flute. She enjoyed classical music, especially Handel. Living with Charles, she learned to tolerate some forms of rock and country music. Libby moved to Blowing Rock in the 1990's and she fell in love with the North Carolina Mountains, while frequently spending time with her family and friends in Salisbury.

In addition to her mother, she is survived by her husband Charles Hoffmire of Blowing Rock, NC; sisters, Vicki Helms Butler and husband Charles of Hiawassee, GA; Pam Helms Clark and husband Word of Winston Salem, NC; niece, Amanda Paige Clark of Greensboro, NC; Special friends, Melissa Butler and Juliet Gainer; Stepdaughters, Jennifer Harvey of Greenville, SC;
