Eric Bruce Mason, 84, of Salisbury, passed away May 28, 2025 at W.G. (Bill) Hefner VA Medical Center Hospice House due to ALS/Lou Gehrig's Disease. Born December 22, 1940 in Valley Falls, SC, he was the son of the late Nathan Walls Mason and the late Bertha Beatrice Taylor Mason. He was a veteran of the United States Navy where he served on the USS Antietam in Pensacola, Florida. After the Navy, he worked for Duke Energy for 32 years until his retirement.

He was a member of Calvary Baptist Church and the Fulton Masonic Lodge where he was Past Master and secretary.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Phyllis "Darlene" Trexler Mason on January 8, 2024 and by four sisters.
