



Eugene "Buddy" Owen Clary

December 17, 1922 - March 9, 2010

Mr. Eugene Owen "Buddy" Clary, 87, of Salisbury, died Tuesday, March 9, 2010 at Autumn Care of Salisbury.

Born December 17, 1922 in Lawrenceville, VA, he was the son of the late Berre Doyle Clary and Albert Estes Clary. After serving in the US 1st Army, Company "B", 32nd Signal Light Construction Battalion, he settled in Salisbury, NC.
