Eulie “Sam” Aiken, Jr., 87, of Reidsville, passed away Friday, June 12, 2015 at the NC State Veterans Nursing Home.

Born November 7, 1927 at Bull Pond Plantation (Allendale), SC, he was the son of the late Virginia Dunbar Aiken and Eulie Aiken, Sr.

Mr. Aiken was a veteran of the US Army, serving during the Korean War and service with the National Guard. He later served many years as an Army recruiter. His devotion to the military and its discipline earned him the loving nickname of “Sarge” by his family and friends.

He completed various trade schools and owned and operated a masonry company in Philadelphia, PA. He later worked for Carolina Steel and Sears DTS Trucking before retiring in civilian life.
