Mr. Everett Dixon Tucker, 91, of Salisbury, NC passed away Tuesday, February 10, 2015 at his residence.

Born August 16, 1923 in Guilford County, he was the son of the late Lydia Dixon and Rush Tucker.

Mr. Tucker was a graduate of Colfax High School. He attended a college for a short time before enlisting and serving in the US Navy during World War II, serving in the South Pacific. After his military service, Mr. Tucker worked for 31 years as an electrician for Walter Carter, Inc. His two favorite things in life were singing and wood working. He was a member of the Hickory Woodturners and Ursinus United Church of Christ where he sang in the choir, served as Elder, Deacon and Trustee.
