Felix Tidwell Adams, Jr., 88, formerly of Woodleaf and recently of the NC State Veterans Nursing Home, Salisbury died Wednesday, July 21, 2010 at the NC State Veterans Nursing Home.

Born April 30, 1922 in Springer, NM, he was the son of the late Eulalia Scott Adams and Felix Tidwell Adams, Sr.

He attended Reynolds High School in Winston-Salem and attended flight school in Florida

Mr. Adams was a pilot for Piedmont Airlines and Eastern Airlines and later sold produce at the Farmers Market on West Innes Street.

He was a veteran of the U S Army Air Corp, serving from December 27, 1939 until September 2, 1945. He attended Gays Chapel United Methodist Church.
