Frances Jackson McIntire, 88, of Salisbury died Friday, June 26, 2009 at the Lutheran Home at Trinity Oaks.

Born January 3, 1921 in Mayadan, she was the daughter of the late John M. and Jenny Keeffe Jackson. She was educated in the Winston-Salem schools.

In the 1940's she sang professionally and was the first lady in Winston-Salem to be on a singing radio show. She sang contemporary Christian music and sang throughout North Carolina at Churches and revivals. Mrs. McIntire operated a nursery for children for 13 years.

She was a member of North Hills Presbyterian Church.

Her husband, Russell Benjamin "Russ" McIntire, Sr. preceded her in death on April 29, 2000.
