Frances Rebecca Pless Alderman, 92, of Salisbury, passed away Wednesday, April 21, 2021 at the Novant Health Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House.

Born March 18, 1929 in Landis, Mrs. Alderman was the daughter of the late Welker Doc Pless and Lela Mae Ramseur Pless.

She graduated from Landis High School, Class of 1947. Mrs. Alderman was employed in the Cannon Mills office for eleven years and was school secretary for 25 years at Wiley and Henderson Elementary Schools.
