Frances Wain Robeson, age 87, died Sunday April 25, 2010 in Chapel Hill. Born April 4, 1923 in Granite Quarry, she was the daughter of the late Mary Ann Mead Wain and George Wain.

Frances graduated from Granite Quarry High School, Pfeiffer Junior College, and UNC-Greensboro. She was secretary to three presidents at Catawba College in Salisbury.
