Mrs. Frances Fisher Whisenant, 88, formerly of Charlotte passed away Tuesday, May 21, 2013 at Trinity Oaks Retirement Community in Salisbury, NC where she resided for the past six months.

Frances was born September 20, 1924 in Cliffside, NC, daughter to the late Fred C. Fisher and Audrey Huntley Fisher. She moved to Charlotte with her family at an early age where she graduated from Long Creek and Charlotte Business School

Frances married Noble J. Whisenant in 1943 beginning a very successful entrepreneurial and giving journey. She and Noble were partners with C.W. Kidd, Jr. and family in the Mecklenburg County Abattoir. Frances and Noble built and operated the Frances Noble Apartments in Crescent Beach, SC until 1986. They then were partners with their family in Eastwood Golf Club in Charlotte from 1992-1999.
