Frances Campbell Williams, 94, of Cleveland, passed away Saturday, October 31, 2020 at her home.

Born June 23, 1926 in Rowan County, she was the daughter of the late Fred Lee Campbell and Lottie Mae Steele Campbell.

Mrs. Williams graduated from Cleveland High School and attended Mitchell College.

She was formerly employed in the Payroll Department of Erwin Mills, Cooleemee and helped operated the family farm with her husband.
