



## Mr. Frank Allen Sides

June 14, 1917 - May 29, 2013

Frank Allen Sides, 95, of Salisbury, passed away Wednesday, May 29, 2013 at Genesis Eldercare of Salisbury.

Born June 14, 1917 in Salisbury, he was the son of the late Valda Estelle Elliotte Sides and James A. Sides.

He graduated from Spencer High School, Class of 1937 and served in the NC National Guard's 105th Engineer Company C for 3 years.

Mr. Sides was employed for Southern Railway, Yarbrough Appliance and Furniture, and Fiber Industries before retiring.

He was a member of Calvary Baptist Church and served as a Sunday School teacher for over 60 years. He would still teach sometimes until the age 89 before giving it up., and served as Church Clerk for 16 years and Sunday School Superintendent for 2 years.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife Malva Kester Sides, "The love of his life," whom he married June 17, 1939 and died September 2, 1981, an infant daughter, Violet May Sides on October 2, 1951, grandson, Scott Patrick Sides, April 18, 1978, granddaughter, Tanya Alina Iddings on January 15, 1969, four sister and two brothers.
