Mrs. Freda Campbell Caudill, 80 of Salisbury went to be with her heavenly Father on Friday, December 22, 2017 with her family by her side. What a day of celebrating it was. She woke up that same day and told her family “I am good”. “I am happy”.

Affectionately known to many young children she kept in her home as “Mama Freda”, she was a loving devoted wife, mother and grandmother. After raising her own children, she went to work at Revco (CVS), F&M Bank and then J. C. Penney.

Before moving her membership to First Baptist Church of Cooleemee, Freda was an active member of Jerusalem Baptist Church where she was involved in the Care Ministry, Prayers and Squares, Women’s Ministries and was Secretary of her Sunday School Class.
