Gary Todd Trexler, 58, of Salisbury, NC passed away Friday, August 4, 2023 at Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House.

Born September 24, 1964 in Rowan County he was the son of the late James Thomas Trexler, Sr. and Margie Gilbert Trexler.

Mr. Trexler was a graduate of East Rowan High School, class of 1982. He earned his associates degree from Rowan Cabarrus Community College, class of 1991. Mr. Trexler worked as a radio announcer with WSAT, WSTP and WHIP as the voice of Lake Norman Wildcats Football, Mooresville Blue Devil Football and Basketball, and American Legion Baseball. He was a member of the National Sportscasters and Sportswriters Association. Gary was a diehard fan of the UNC Tarheels and the Dallas Cowboys.
