George Julian Busby, 68, of Salisbury died Saturday, October 8, 2011 at his residence.

Born Nov. 12, 1942 in Salisbury, he is the son of Dorothy Rudy Busby of Salisbury and the late Dr. George Francis Busby.

He was educated in the Salisbury schools, graduated from Boyden High School, Class of 1960 and the University of Michigan's School of Architecture in Ann Arbor, MI in December 1965. Mr. Busby was an Eagle Scout and attended numerous Jamborees and Philmont Scout Ranch.

Mr. Busby was an architect and practiced in Ft. Lauderdale, FL until he retired and returned to Salisbury in December 2003.

He was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church, active in the Ruffy Holmes Computer Club and was instrumental in founding the Salisbury Cultural Arts Barbecue Festival.
