August 24, 1918 - April 11, 2014

George Redding, 95, of Mars Hill, NC and formerly of Spencer, NC, died April 11th at Madison Health and Rehab in Mars Hill NC, after several months of declining health.

Born August 24, 1918 in Salisbury, Mr. Redding, a son of the late Joseph Walter and Atha Julian Redding, was a graduate of Spencer High School, served in the United States Marine Corp in WWII, and worked 42 years as a trainman for the Southern Railroad until he retired in 1981.

He enjoyed travel and vacations, hunting and fishing, reading, but most of all his family and friends.

He was preceded in death by his first wife of 60 years Rachel Brattain Redding (2001), his brother Joseph Walter Redding, Jr. (1997), and his sister Darlene Redding Klutz (2013).

Survivors include his second wife of ten years, Dixie Freeman of Mars Hill, NC; sons Michael Redding of Fredericksburg, Va., and Stephen Redding (Myra) of Pulaski, VA; and three grandchildren, Patrick Redding (Noelle) of Spencer, NC, Caitlin Christian (Dave) of Lynchburg, VA, and Candice Redding of Pulaski, VA.
