Gerry Craig Parham, 60, of Salisbury, went home to be with the Lord on Friday, June 1, 2018. He passed away at Carolinas Medical Center – Charlotte.

Born in Buncombe County on August 27, 1957, he was the son of the late William Sam Parham and Myrna Bartlett Parham.

Gerry graduated from Kings Mountain High School in 1975 and received his Bachelor's Degree from the University of North Carolina – Asheville in 1979. He spent 17 years teaching Latin at Mt. Tabor High School in Winston-Salem, North Carolina and retired in 2009.

Gerry faithfully attended First Baptist Church of Salisbury and was a member of the Jeremiah 29:11 Sunday school class.

He was affectionately called “Goat” or “Gappo” and was a member of the UNCA Mud 500 Club.
