



## Glenn Joseph Horning

March 19, 1930 - June 23, 2014

Glenn Joseph Horning, 84, of Salisbury, passed away Monday, June 23, 2014 at his residence.

Born March 19, 1930 in Akron, OH, he was the son of late Clarence Horning and Clara Lukart Horning. He resided in Kent, OH until moving to Salisbury, NC in 1998 to be closer to family.

Educated at Kent State High School, Kent, OH and served in the US Air Force during the Korean War.

His career was as a telecommunications linesman regional operator and engineering information executive for Western Reserve, Mid-Continent Telephone Company and Alltel before retiring.

Member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Kent, OH as well as Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Salisbury, NC where he served as an usher. He was an active member of the Knights of Columbus where he served as Treasurer for 16 years with St. Patrick's Church and Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Salisbury, volunteering his whole life to improving facilities and operations. One of his jobs at St. Patrick's Church was to make sure the Bell Tower always rung accordingly for services. He did many odd jobs and constantly

volunteering of several organizations to help complete projects. He served as a Boy Scout Leader, enjoyed restoring old cars, doing home projects and occasionally being seen driving his 1966 Ford Mustang. One of his favorite pastimes was going to NC State football games where his son David played.

He was a dedicated husband and supportive father. He enjoyed golf and was a member of GARS and was on several bowling leagues. He had a very kind heart and was always willing to help anyone. He will be missed by his children, grandchildren, and friends.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Mary Grace Rabatsky Horning on October 6, 2004, brothers John Horning and William Horning.
