Graham Rex Madison, age 106, of Winston Salem passed away Wednesday, June 1, 2011 at Kate B. Reynolds Hospice House.

Mr. Madison was born August 4, 1904 in Iredell County the son of the late Minnie White Madison and Thomas Jefferson Madison. He graduated from Union Grove High School, High Point College and earned a Masters Degree from Duke University. He was a public school teacher, coach and principal; part owner of Mocksville Builders Supply; Executive Vice President of Mocksville Savings and Loan; Real Estate Broker, partner in Davie Reality Company and Tour Director for Madison Tours.

Mr. Madison was a member of First Baptist Church of Mocksville where he was a Deacon, Sunday School Teacher, Sunday School Director and sang in the choir. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge for more than 50 years; Past President of Mocksville Rotary Club; Chairman of Davie County Board of Education and Chairman of Davie County Hospital Board. He was awarded the Order of the Long Leaf Pine one of the highest honors presented to a N.C. citizen.

Preceding him in death was his wife of 73 years Gertrude H. Madison who died January 16, 2008; brothers Espy, Charlie, Royd , and Clay Madison; sisters Eugenia M. Rash and Lessie Madison.

Survivors include his daughters Glenda M. Long and husband Fred of Salisbury and “Gene” M. Rauch and husband Bob of Mocksville; 5 grandchildren, 12 great-grandchildren, and one great-great granddaughter..
