Hannah Shaud Barton of Delray Beach, FL, died Monday, June 8, 2009 in Alexandria LA.

Mrs. Barton was born April 9, 1921 in Philadelphia PA. She was the daughter of the late Joseph Shaud and Eva Eckhart and sister of Eve Weems and the late Gertrude Kenna.
