Hardy R. Gudger, Jr., 72 of Salisbury died Monday, June 8, 2009 at Rowan Regional Medical Center.

Born November 25, 1936 in Salisbury he was the son of the late Ruth Schenk Cook and Hardy R. Gudger, Sr. He was educated in the Salisbury schools and graduated from Boyden High School in 1955.

Mr. Gudger was a 20 year veteran of the US Navy during the Vietnam War before retiring in 1974 with the rank of E6. He later worked 20 years for Cone Mills before retiring. He was a member and two time Commander of the Samuel C. Hart American Legion Post 14.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Daisy Patterson Gudger on February 27, 2002.

Survivors include his children, Michael S. Gudger of Winston-Salem, Johnny L. Gudger, Linda M. Conkel, Susan R. Burrell and Timothy D. Gudger, all of Salisbury. Nine grandchildren and 3 great-grandchildren also survive.
