



## Harold Benjamin Ervin, Jr.

Mr. Harold Benjamin Ervin, Jr., 82, of Salisbury, NC passed away Saturday, April 28, 2012 at Rowan Regional Medical Center.

Born November 30, 1929 in Charlotte, NC, he was the only child of Harold Benjamin Ervin, Sr. and Hope McAlpine Bell Ervin. Mr. Ervin graduated from Boyden High School in Salisbury, NC in 1948. He studied art at Richmond Polytechnic Institute (RPI), a branch of William and Mary in Richmond, VA.

Mr. Ervin was a veteran of the U.S. Army, where he served as Forward Artillery Observer in the Korean War.

In his later years he enjoyed painting and won a number of awards along with becoming an art collector. He also found great joy in collecting and driving older classic cars. Mr. Ervin always showed a great love of animals as well as rescuing stray cats and bringing them into his home.
