Pastor Harold D. Hughes of Salisbury, formerly of Andrews, went to be with the Lord on Friday, August 3, 2012 at Rowan Regional Medical Center.

He was born August 7, 1930 in Cherokee County to the late John Lee and Zula Byrd Hughes. Pastor Hughes was the Pastor of Sherrills Ford Road Baptist Church in Salisbury since 1987.
