Harold Mowery, Jr., 89, of Salisbury, passed away at Novant Health Rowan Medical Center on October 23, 2023.

Harold was born in Salisbury, North Carolina on August 8, 1934, to Harold Mowery, Sr. and Rose Wiley Mowery. He graduated from Boyden High School in 1952, and he married Margaret Rose Wagoner in 1957. He served in the US Army Corps of Engineers, Fort Jackson, NC, from 1957 to 1963, and graduated from North Carolina State University with a B.S. in Civil Engineering. He was a member of the Sigma Nu Fraternity.

Harold worked as a project manager for Wagoner Construction Company, Inc. for most of his career, building for the commercial, industrial, and hospitality industries in multiple states. He served as a Director for Home Savings and Loan Association, and as a Director for Omni Capital Group. He was a life-long member of St. John's Lutheran Church, where he served as an usher, on church council, and on numerous committees including the property committee, personnel committee, and others.

Harold enjoyed playing golf, hunting, and traveling. He enjoyed spending time at the beach and at home with his wife, children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. He loved working in his shop, using his creativity and inventiveness for numerous projects.
