Harry Glenn "Boonie" Young, Jr., 85 of Salisbury, passed away Sunday, May 3, 2020 at Autumn Care of Salisbury.

Born September 24, 1934 in the Yadkin Community of Rowan County, he was the son of the late Florence Holshouser Young and Harry Glenn Young, Sr.

He was educated in the Spencer and Salisbury schools and graduated from Boyden High School, Class of 1952. Mr. Young received a scholarship to play football at Catawba College and graduated in 1956. He enjoyed golf, running and was a member of the YMCA.

Mr. Young was a Furniture Sales Representative for American of Martinsville for 35 years before retiring.

He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Salisbury where he served as an Usher, was a former Deacon and Sunday School teacher.
