Harry Lewis Hipp, Jr., 85, of Salisbury, passed away Friday, March 12, 2021 at Novant Health Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House.

Born June 30, 1935 in Rowan County, he was the son of the late Cora Maness Hipp and Harry Lewis Hipp, Sr.

Mr. Hipp was educated in the Rowan County schools, graduated from Cleveland High School and served in the U.S. Army Reserves.

He was employed for Fiber Industries/Hoechst Celanese Corp. for 29 years before retiring in 1997. He was also a farmer that raised cattle and had a peach orchard.

Mr. Hipp was a life-long member of the First United Church of Christ where he served on the Church Consistory.
