



Harry Curtis Stone Jr.

August 15, 1929 - July 17, 2022

Harry Curtis Stone Jr., 92, of Salisbury, died Sunday July 17, 2022 at Morningside of Raleigh in Raleigh, NC.

He was born August 15th, 1929 in Lumberton, NC to Harry and Jacqueline Stone. Harry was educated in the Robeson County school system where he graduated from Lumberton High School in 1947. He went on to attend the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and graduated in 1951 with a degree in Pharmacy. In early 1952, during the Korean War, he entered the U.S. Navy as an Engineering Officer. After the Navy he went into Pharmacy full time. He moved to Salisbury and started working at Fulton Street Pharmacy in 1960. He was a member of the Kiwanis club. Harry married the love of his life, Martha Peeler, in 1966. After working at Fulton Street for seven years, he purchased the Pharmacy in 1967. He worked in Pharmacy for 35 years. Most of that time was spent in Salisbury at Fulton Street. Fulton Street Pharmacy with its soda fountain was a Salisbury icon that many graduates of Boyden (later Salisbury) High School remember well.

Harry was a member of First Baptist Church in Salisbury for over 60 years. After he retired from Pharmacy he devoted his life to his church. He served as a Deacon and then a Deacon emeritus. He also worked for many years as a volunteer Pharmacist for the church's Good Shepherd clinic.

He leaves behind his son David Stone, daughter-in-law Babette Stone, and granddaughter Sarah Stone.

The family will receive friends from 10-11 AM Saturday (July 23) at First

Baptist Church. The funeral service will follow at 11 AM at First Baptist Church with Rev. Kenneth Lance officiating. Burial will follow the service at City Memorial Park.
