Haynes Carpenter Murdoch passed away at the Glenn Kiser Hospice House on January 10, 2025. Haynes was the son of William and Isabelle Murdoch. Born in Salisbury on March 14, 1953, Haynes attended Boyden High School and North Carolina State University, where he fell in love with his wife Laura. Devoted to his family, his church, and his community, Haynes served as a scout leader for troop 448, a leader in his children's youth groups, held numerous leadership positions with his church, and dedicated as many fall weekends as possible to NC State football.

Haynes greatly enjoyed traveling, hiking, camping, and sharing experiences with family and friends. He always jumped at the opportunity to cook a whole hog and was known world over for his ingenuity and ability to improve upon less than optimal engineering decisions.

Haynes is preceded in death by his parents William and Isabelle, and his brothers Julian and Worth.

“ Haynes and I have been friends for a long time, since square 0.1. Our Moms were good friends and they started us off on that track, which we stayed on for 70 years. The story is that they put us down for naps in the same crib, and it went on from there. We were fortunate to grow up in Salisbury during the 50s and 60s, and the story was an extended episode of ‘Leave it to Beaver’, with all of the happenings and characters that shape kids into who they become. Haynes was one of the main characters. We did a lot of stuff that bordered on commendable, and a lot that was just shy of condemnable. We fully explored all of the space between the rails of acceptable behavior, but one of the things I most remember about Haynes was that he knew where the rails were and he never stepped out of bounds – not far, anyway - although we had many chances. We like to blame our peers for the poor character traits we develop. Instead, I would give Haynes a lot of credit for staying the course. The experiences we had are something I would not trade for anything I have ever heard or read about. I am confident that he passed the best of these traits along to his children and grandchildren, and that they will continue to benefit from the experiences we had together, in a world which I am afraid may no longer exist. This, to me, would be his legacy. I am glad that I got to share in it.
