Mrs. Helen Hardister Leazer, 90 of Salisbury passed away on Wednesday, September 22, 2010 at Rowan Regional Medical Center.

Born October 25, 1919 in Lexington, NC she was the daughter of the late Mr. Charlie M. Hardister and Ethel Maley Hardister.

Mrs. Leazer was a graduate of Lexington High School, Class of 1936. She was employed in the 1950's with Colonial Stores and later with Food Town for 22 years in the meat department.
