



Henry C. Hubbard, Jr.

January 5, 1921 - September 14, 2011

Mr. Henry “Hank” Chatham Hubbard, Jr. 90, of Salisbury passed away September 14, 2011 at The Lutheran Home at Trinity Oaks.

Born January 5, 1921 in Winston Salem, NC to the late Henry Chatham Hubbard and Esta Pardue Hubbard, he was educated at Boyden High School, Catawba College and Vanderbilt University Graduate School.

A veteran of World War II, he was commissioned a 2nd Lieutenant in the Infantry, then trained to be a B-25 pilot, serving as a 1st Lieutenant in the Pacific Theater with the 345th Bomb Group.

After the war he worked from 1946-1957 at the Salisbury Post Office, then completed his education and located in Silver Spring, MD, where he worked as a physicist at the then-named Naval Ordnance Laboratory, White Oak. He retired from the Naval Surface Weapons Center, White Oak, MD, in 1982 as Supervisory Physicist, Underwater Systems Assessment Division, Response and Environmental Measurements.

Mr. Hubbard is survived by his wife of 67 years, Pauline (Polly) Washburn Hubbard; a brother, Joel S. Hubbard; sisters, Ruth Young, Jane Morton, Sara Fairey, and fifteen nieces and nephews.
