Herman Gilbert Ritchie, 93, of Salisbury, passed away September 24, 2024 at Liberty Commons.

Born December 17, 1930 in Rowan County, he was the son of the late Ila Clementine Brown Ritchie and Gilbert Henderson Ritchie. He was a graduate of Granite Quarry High School and a Veteran of the U.S. Army. He retired from Kern Rubber Company and raised beef cattle. He enjoyed watching the Atlanta Braves.

A lifelong member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, he had served as Assistant Treasurer for the Sunday School. He was a member of the Board of Directors of South Salisbury Fire Department for 36 years, serving as Chairman for 19 years.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his wife Mary Shoaf "Polly" Ritchie on March 7, 2010. They were married May 27, 1960.
