



## Hilda Goodman Foreman

July 12, 1932 - October 15, 2010

Hilda Lee Goodman Foreman, 78, of Salisbury, died Friday, Oct. 15, 2010, at Rowan Regional Medical Center.

Born July 12, 1932, in McDowell County, NC, she was a daughter of the late Ralph Watts Goodman and Annie Lee Morris Goodman.

A graduate of Western Carolina with a Masters in Math Education, she was affiliated with Catawba College for 30+ years, first as a teacher of mathematics and later as a library technical associate.

Mrs. Foreman was a member of First Presbyterian Church for more than 50 years, where she was active in the music programs, especially the handbell choir, and served as a volunteer in numerous other roles.

She has served as treasurer of the Helen S. and Julian L. Goldman Scholarship Fund since its inception in 1965, and was a life member of AAUW (American Association of University Women).

Her parents and her brother, Harold Watts Goodman, preceded her in death.

Survivors include her husband of 52 years, Thomas Alexander Foreman, Jr., her daughter, Daphne Anne Foreman, of New York City, sisters Agnes Lowder

of Hampton, VA, and Daphne Nelson of Wilmington, NC; and numerous nieces and nephews.

Service: Memorial Service is at 11 a.m. Tuesday at First Presbyterian Church, with the Rev. Dr. Jim Dunkin and the Rev. Dr. Randal V. Kirby officiating, to be followed by a reception in Lewis Hall.
