Homer Lee Huskins, age 85, of Salisbury passed away Wednesday July 22, at Forsyth Medical Center.

Mr. Huskins was born June 5, 1930 in McDowell County the son of the late Dollie Washburn Huskins and E. W. Huskins. He attended Burnsville Schools and was a graduate of Berea College in Kentucky. He was a Veteran of the US Army and was a M.P. Homer was employed with Brad Ragan Inc. for 40 years and retired from Goodyear. He was owner/operator of RDH Tire Co in Cleveland.
