Mr. Jack Hackney Pickett, 85, of Spencer, passed away Monday, May 24, 2010 at Rowan Regional Medical Center.

Born January 2, 1925 in Spencer, he was the son of the late Joseph Hiram Pickett and Lessie Latta Pickett. He graduated from Spencer High School and attended Catawba College.

Mr. Pickett worked for Southern Railroad for 43 years as a Car Inspector/Repairman. He retired in January 1986.

He was a life long member of First Baptist Church of Spencer where he served in many areas of the church, including, Deacon, Usher, Sunday School Superintendent, and Trustee. He also was a member of the Men's Fellowship and helped with planning meals for families during funeral times.

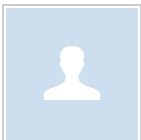
