Mrs. Jane Edwards Cutrell, 87, of Salisbury, NC passed away Wednesday, April 17, 2013 at The Lutheran Home at Trinity Oaks.

Born July 17, 1925 in Ashland, IL to the late Lester C. Edwards and Lorene Hierman Edwards, she was a graduate of Ashland High School Class of 1943. Mrs. Cutrell worked as a secretary in Chicago, IL until moving to Salisbury, NC in 1951. She was a secretary to the contractor who built the W.G. Hefner VA Medical Center in Salisbury and in 1953 began working as a secretary in Social Work Services at the W.G. Hefner Medical Center until her retirement in 1986.
