Jesse Lewis Morgan, 88, went home to be with his Lord & Savior on December 13, 2020. He passed away peacefully surrounded by his daughters as they recited Psalm 23- his favorite Bible passage. He was born on August 29, 1932, in Campobello, SC, to the late Thomas Lee & Bessie Page Morgan. He graduated from New Prospect High School in SC- never missing a day of school the entire 12 years! He was the youngest of 6 children. He is survived by his sister, Gertrude Bradley of Inman, SC.

Jesse was also preceded in death by his loving wife of 58 years, Annette Miller Morgan. She was truly the love of his life! He was an honest and hardworking man, who was dedicated to his Lord, wife, children, extended family, church and community.
