survived by his only child, James Cameron Sherrill; as well as 4 stepchildren, Will Piper, Belle Piper, Meghan Elizabeth Clifton and Evan Clifton. His sisters, Rebecca Sherrill Blankenship and Sylvia Butler-Sherrill are mourning him as well.
