Mr. John Ridley Steele, 58, of Mt Ulla, NC passed away Saturday, September 29, 2018 at Wake Forest Baptist Medical Center.

He was born March 26, 1960 in Rowan County, NC to the late Robert Hall Steele and Roselind Holloman Steele. Mr. Steele graduated from Mars Hill College and was owner of Steele Feed and Seed. He was very active with West Rowan Fire Department for over 40 years and served on the Rowan County Board of Elections.

Mr. Steele was a member of Thyatira Presbyterian Church where he served as a deacon and was President of The Men of the Church.

Surviving is his life partner, Joyce Adkins; brother, Robert Vann Steele and wife June of Mocksville, NC; sister, Mary Margaret Steele of Wake Forest, NC; and nieces, Elizabeth Steele Patterson (Jared) of Tupelo, Mississippi and Margaret Brooke Steele (Brandon Davis) of Mocksville, NC. He is also survived by his extended family, Brandon Douglas, Taylor Adkins and Kate Adkins, who lovingly called him "Papa John".

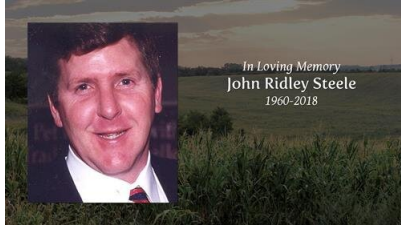
