Joseph Stephen Harrell, 75, of Salisbury, passed away Saturday, July 4, 2020 at his home.

Born July 11, 1944 in Augusta, GA, he was the son of the late Lillie Mae Griffin Harrell and Carlton Kent Harrell, Sr.
