



Juanita Safrit Williams

August 10, 1917 - August 22, 2011

Juanita Safrit Williams, 94, died Monday, August 22, 2011, at the Lutheran Home at Trinity Oaks.

Mrs. Williams was born August 10, 1917, in Salisbury, the daughter of the late James Lee and Anna Wagner Safrit. Educated in the Salisbury City schools, she graduated from Boyden High School in 1934.

She was a life long member of St. John's Lutheran Church, Salisbury, and was active in the ARC of Rowan in its early stages of development. She had her own catering business for 35 years.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Floyd Leon Williams on July 25, 1962, and one brother, James Monroe Safrit.

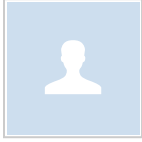
