



Judson Hamon Enloe

February 25, 1927 - January 3, 2015

Judson Hamon Enloe, 87, of Salisbury, passed away Saturday, January 3, 2015 at the NC State Veterans Nursing Home.

Born February 25, 1927 in Judson, NC, he was the son of the late Herbert Carlyle Enloe and Annie Cochran Enloe.

He was educated in the Swain and Transylvania County schools and graduated from Brevard High School, Class of 1945. Mr. Enloe was a veteran of the US Army during World War II and served with the 47th Infantry and 9th Infantry. He helped transport war criminals to Nuremburg, Germany for trial.

He was employed by NC Finishing Company, Fiber Industries and retired from Kern Roll Rubber Company (Permaflex). After retiring he worked part-time at Carolina Tire, and Rowan Cabarrus Community College delivering mail.

A member of Stallings Memorial Baptist Church, Bost/Barringer Sunday School Class, he served as Deacon Emeritus, Trustee, Director of Training Union and the Bus Ministry. He was also a member of the VFW and the Patriotic Sons of America.

Mr. Enloe was preceded in death by his first wife of 25 years, Mary Margaret Juboor Enloe on July 30, 1981 and his second wife, Reba Bush Enloe on

September 10, 2006, his brother, Carl Enloe and sister, Louise Hogsed.
