



Mrs June Caroline Ervin

July 1, 1930 - March 19, 2014

Mrs. June Caroline Brantley Ervin, lifelong resident of Salisbury, died at home on March 19, 2014. She quickly changed from her earthly life to her spiritual heavenly home.

Mrs. Ervin was born at the former Whitehead-Stokes Hospital in Salisbury on July 1, 1930 to Fallie Shoaf Brantley and James Carson Brantley, and was their only child. She graduated in the Boyden High School Class of 1948. In 1952 she received her Bachelor of Arts degree from Duke University.

June was Marketing Director for the Lutheran Nursing Home at Trinity Oaks for 24 years. A lifelong member of St. John's Lutheran Church, during her earlier years she taught Sunday School, and was president of the adult choir. She was also president of the Salisbury-Rowan Choral Society.

June was known to be especially compassionate with all animals and was the recipient of the Susan J. Gloeckler Memorial Award for Animal Welfare from the Humane Society of Rowan County. She spent most of her life rescuing cats and caring for them. She had previously enjoyed riding her horse, showing in horse shows and riding in drag fox hunts.

In 1976 she married a high school classmate, Harold Benjamin Ervin, Jr. He was the love of her life. They enjoyed many adventures together, including

becoming ardent tennis players until they were nearly 70. They particularly enjoyed participating in Scottish events, especially those at Grandfather Mountain in Linville, NC. Hal passed away on April 28, 2012.

Left to cherish her memory are many beloved cousins, a step-daughter, Kristina Pinkerton, her husband George and their son Andy of New Jersey and step-son, Jeff Ervin and his son Jeffrey of Randleman, NC.
