



## Katharyn Earnhardt Weaver

April 20, 1914 - July 11, 2009

Katharyn Earnhardt Weaver, 95 of Salisbury died Saturday, July 11, 2009 after a period of declining health.

Born April 20, 1914 in Salisbury, she was the daughter of the late Walter A. and Cora Holshouser Earnhardt. She was educated at Boyden High School and Salisbury Business College.

She was one of Salisbury's first policewomen and then worked in the Tax Department of the City of Salisbury until her retirement.
