Kathleen Marie Kennedy Thomas, 88, of Salisbury, NC passed away Monday, May 26, 2025, at Trinity Oaks Health and Rehab.

Mrs. Thomas was born on September 29, 1936, in Philadelphia, PA to the late Margaret Pahls Kenndy and Hugh Kennedy.

She served as a missionary with her husband Ned Thomas with Wycliffe Bible Translators in Quito, Ecuador for 14 years and in Waxhaw, NC at the JAARS Center until she retired in 2003. She had various jobs as a secretary, a typing teacher, an administrative assistant, and a receptionist. She was a member at St. Mark's Lutheran Church in China Grove, NC.

She is survived by her husband of 68 years Ned Welker Thomas, Sr., children: Lauren Thomas of Grants, NM, Ned Thomas Jr. (Deborah) of Eagle Pass, TX, Margaret Thorsen (Rev. 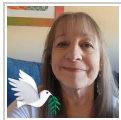

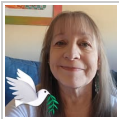
