Mr. Larry Dixon Peeler, 78, of Salisbury, NC passed away Wednesday, July 15, 2015 at Novant Forsyth Medical Center from a brain aneurysm.

Born May 13, 1937 in Rowan Co, NC to the late Lillian Caldwell Peeler and Clifford Alexander Peeler, he attended Salisbury City Schools and UNC Chapel Hill. Mr. Peeler graduated from Catawba College. For several years he worked in the finance department of the Cheerwine Bottling Company. He was involved in many charitable organizations including the Nazareth Children's Home, Gateway Freedom Center and Young Life.

Mr. Peeler joined the Civitan Club of Salisbury in 1989. He served as President of the Salisbury club from 1999-2000 and Lt. Governor for the organization. He was active in many club projects.
