Mr. Lewis Boyd Jacobs, Jr., 77, of Granite Quarry, passed away Thursday, April 7, 2011 at Baptist Hospital in Winston-Salem, NC.

Born January 24, 1934 in Granite Quarry, NC he was the son of the late Virginia Hudson Jacobs and Lewis Boyd Jacobs.

Mr. Jacobs was educated in Granite Quarry schools. He was a graduate of Catawba College and received a master's degree from Appalachian State University.
