Linda Sue Mundy White, 72, of Salisbury, NC passed Thursday, July 24, 2025 at her residence.

Born August 23, 1952 in Cabarrus County, she was the daughter of the late Eva Allene Swink and James Coleman Mundy. She grew up in the Washington, DC area and was a graduate of Taipei American High School, class of 1970.

Linda's life was a beautiful symphony — composed with love, dedication, and music. From the time she picked up her first flute at the age of five, music became her lifelong companion and calling. She played with the Junior National Symphony. Her talent and passion carried her far, performing locally, nationally, and even internationally. But perhaps her greatest joy came not only from performing, but from sharing that joy with others.

Linda poured her heart into teaching, offering private lessons and volunteering at high schools to support and mentor young flutists. Her gentle guidance, encouragement, and musicianship left a lasting impact on countless students over the years.

In her retirement, Linda found renewed joy and connection through the Piedmont Primetime Community Band. Being a part of that group brought music back into her daily life and filled her days with purpose and community.

Along with her parents, preceding her in death are her brothers, Steve and Mike Mundy.

Beyond her musical gifts, Linda's greatest pride and joy was her family. She is lovingly remembered by her sister, Carol Goe (Tony) of Arizona; two daughters, Stephanie (Kevin Blackburn) from Stanfield, NC; and Renae (Kevin Aycock) from Salisbury, NC; her three grandchildren, Alisha Blackburn of Orlando, FL, Megan Youngblood (Jared) of Spanaway, Washington, and Mary Kathryn Aycock of Salisbury, NC; and her precious great-granddaughter, Alina Youngblood; along with numerous nieces and nephews.

Linda's legacy lives on — not only in the music she made and the students she taught, but in the love she gave so freely to her family and friends. She will be deeply missed and lovingly remembered.
