



## Linnie Daniel "Dink" Eller

October 8, 1918 - June 27, 2014

Mr. Linnie Daniel "Dink" Eller, 95, of Salisbury, passed away Friday June, 27, 2014 at Carillon Assisted Living of Salisbury.

Born October, 8, 1918 in Rowan County he was the son of the late John Henry Eller and Lillie Crowell Eller.

Mr. Eller was a graduate of Spencer High School, and he was a veteran of the Army Air Corps during WWII serving in Iceland.
